CIRCULAR

Sub: Guidelines for effecting Migration Transfer for the year 2017-18.

As per MCI amendment notification dated: 15-02-2012, clause 6(1) (2) states that Migration of students from one college to another is permissible only if both the colleges are recognized by Central Government under section 11(2) the IMC Act 1956.

Further as per Clause 6(1)(4) the office of Director of Medical Education will take a final decision in the matter as to whether or not to allow migration in accordance with the provisions of these regulations and communicate the same to the applicant student within a period of One month from the date of receipt of the request for migration.

1. Recognized Medical Colleges should publish the number of seats available for Migration Transfer in their respective website under intimation to this office. The number of seats available for Migration Transfer subject to the condition that it shall not exceed 5% of the sanctioned annual intake capacity of the college.
2. Recognized Medical colleges wherein the students have opted for out of the Institution and all the medical colleges wherein the students have opted to come into the Institution shall invite applications for Migration Transfer from interested candidates.
3. The Medical Colleges from where the student is opting out and the receiving Medical College where the student is opting to come in shall prepare a merit list of all applicants who have applied for Migration Transfer.
4. The Medical Colleges shall invite the migration transfer application till 6.10.2017
5. Issue of NOC shall commence from 7.10.2017 onwards.
6. Students shall receive No Objection Certificate in Order of merit secured in 1st MBBS examinations from outgoing Medical College and receiving Medical College subject to the condition that Migration Transfer in both the outgoing and receiving Medical Colleges is restricted to 5% of the annual sanctioned in the capacity of college by 13.10.2017.
7. The Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences is requested to issue "No Objection Certificate" to eligible candidates.

8. The students possessing No Objection Certificates from the outgoing Medical College, receiving Medical College and RGUHS shall apply in prescribed format, along with undertaking and original No Objection Certificates to the Director of Medical Education as on or before 13.10.2017.
9. The Director of Medical Education will in turn refer these students to Medical Board whenever necessary.
10. The Medical Board shall give its opinion regarding eligibility for migration transfer.
11. The Directorate of Medical Education will issue Migration Orders to eligible candidates on or before 8.11.2017.
12. Such of the students who have been given Migration Orders shall report to receiving Medical College by 13.11.2017.
13. Wide Publicity shall be given to all the students seeking Migration Transfer about the schedule by putting up the circular in all the Institutional website and Notice Boards, to ensure transparency and provide equal opportunity to all meritorious candidates.
14. All Migration transfers are effect as per the existing Medical Council of India rules and regulations.
15. A fresh Government order in this regard will be issued soon. Such transfers are subject to final approval by Medical Council of India.

NOTIFICATION

The Government of Karnataka is hereby notifying the Guidelines for Migration Transfer for students who have completed first year MBBS course and seek transfer from one Medical College to another Medical College for the year 2015-16 is as follows:

1. All the Medical Colleges should publish the number of seats available for Migration Transfer in their respective website under intimation to Directorate of Medical Education Office. The number of seats available for Migration Transfer subject to the condition that it shall not exceed 5% of the sanctioned annual intake capacity of the college.
2. All the Medical Colleges wherein the students have opted for out of the Institution and all the medical colleges wherein the students have opted to come into the Institution shall invite applications for Migration Transfer from interested candidates.
3. The Medical Colleges from where the student is opting out and the receiving Medical College where the student is opting to come in shall prepare a merit list of all applicants who have applied for Migration Transfer.
4. Students shall receive No Objection Certificate in order of merit from the outgoing Medical College and the receiving Medical College subject to the condition that Migration Transfer in both the outgoing and receiving Medical Colleges be restricted to 5% of the annual sanctioned intake capacity of the college by 2nd November 2015.
5. The Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences is requested to issue "No Objection Certificate" to eligible candidates.
6. The student possessing No Objection Certificates from the outgoing Medical College, receiving Medical College and RGUHS shall apply in prescribed format, along with undertaking and original No Objection Certificates to the Director of Medical Education.
7. The Director of Medical Education will in turn refer these students to Medical Board immediately.
8. The Medical Board shall give its opinion regarding eligibility for migration transfer.

9. The Directorate of Medical Education will issue Migration orders to eligible candidates on 5th November 2015
10. Such of the students who have been given Migration Orders shall report to the receiving Medical College by 9th November, 2015.
11. Wide publicity shall be given to all the students seeking Migration Transfer about the schedule by putting up the circular in all the Institutional Website and Notice Boards, to ensure transparency & provide equal opportunity to all meritorious candidates.
12. All students seeking Migration Transfer shall apply in prescribed format, along with undertaking and original No Objection Certificates.
13. All Migration transfers are affected as per the existing Medical Council of India rules and regulations.
14. Such transfers are subject to final approval by Medical Council of India.
