**Sub.: - Recognition/approval of Bangalore Medical College and Research Institute, Bangalore for the award of MBBS degree granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore against the increased intake i.e. from 150 to 250 seats u/s 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956 - regarding.**

Sir,

I am directed to inform you that the assessments to assess the standard of examination held by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore and to assess the physical and the other teaching facilities available for recognition/approval of Bangalore Medical College and Research Institute, Bangalore for the award of MBBS degree granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore against the increased intake i.e. from 150 to 250 seats u/s 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956 were carried out by the Council assessors on 06.01.2016 and 10.02.2016 & 11.02.2016. The Assessment reports were considered by the Executive Committee at its meeting held on 27.02.2016. The following recommendations of the Executive Committee was approved by the General Body of the Council at its meeting held on 30<sup>th</sup> March, 2016:-

*"The Executive Committee of the Council considered the assessment reports (6<sup>th</sup> January, 2016 and 10<sup>th</sup>/11<sup>th</sup> February, 2016) and decided to recommend to the Central Government for recognition/approval of Bangalore Medical College and Research Institute, Bangalore for the award of MBBS degree granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore against the increased intake i.e. from 150 to 250 seats u/s 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.*

*The Executive Committee further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Sections 8(3)(2), 8(3)(3) & 8(3)(4) of the Establishment of Medical Colleges Regulations (Amendment), 2010 (Part II) dated 16<sup>th</sup> April 2010 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-*

8 (3) ...

*(2) The recognition so granted to an Undergraduate Course for award of MBBS degree shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.*

*(3) The procedure for 'Renewal' of recognition shall be same as applicable for the award of recognition.*

*(4) Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-clause (a) supra shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Undergraduate Course of MBBS at the said institute...."*

In view of above, you are requested to issue necessary notification at the earliest recognizing Bangalore Medical College and Research Institute, Bangalore for the award of MBBS degree granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore against the increased intake i.e. from 150 to 250 seats.

A copy of assessment report is enclosed herewith.
